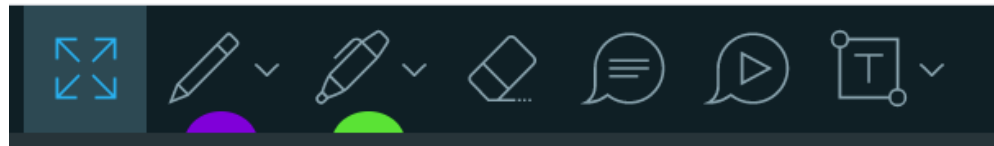

When these directional arrows are pressed, it allows you to use your fingers to move and zoom around the page. This is here to stop you accidentally drawing over your work (though there is a back button to undo just in case!)

Clicking here selects the pen tool. This allows you to draw and write in Showbie. Tap the pen again and you can choose your colour and pen thickness.
Tip - Use the thinnest pen and zoom in to your work to get the neatest handwriting!

This icon selects the highlighter. Your teachers can still yellow and green your work using this tool!

Eraser to rub out anything you don't want on the page.

The box with a 'T' in it allows you to create a text box. These allow you to choose different size/colour/font text types unlike the 'comment' tool and can be really useful when you need different coloured text. Tapping the icon twice will bring up the options. Holding your finger down on a created text box will let you delete it.

The speech bubble with the play button in allows you to speak comments into your device using the microphone. These are the perfect way to add your own voice to your work and verbally complete tasks. They are collapsible, which means if you tap them, they disappear into bubbles which can be moved anywhere on the page

This speech bubble with lines in allows you to write comments and then move them around. These are the perfect way to add typed text to your work. They are collapsible, which means if you tap them, they disappear into bubbles which can be moved to anywhere on the page. .
