



Zoom Celebration Assembly

Whitmore Park School is 70 years old this year and we would like to celebrate by bringing each class together for a Zoom Assembly!

This is also a wonderful opportunity for all of the children to keep in touch with each other and see their friends in a safe space.

Children will need to be supported by a parent/carer to access the assemblies and the links will be sent to parents' email addresses.

The assemblies will start with a short presentation from each class teacher about the opening of the school in 1951.

In preparation for the assemblies, it would be great if children could find out a few things:

- Did your parents or grandparents attend Whitmore Park?
- Can they tell you any of their memories about it?

For children currently at the school:

- What is the best thing about our school?
- What are you looking forward to doing in the half term holiday?

We may ask the children to use the chat function to respond to these questions.

We will have some protocols for the meeting:

- Teachers will use virtual waiting rooms to allow children in – this will allow them to check who is entering the Zoom assembly.
- Children must have cameras on and microphones muted before they are allowed to enter the Zoom assembly.
- Everyone must be on time for the assembly. After 5 minutes, teachers will no longer be able to admit anyone.
- Parents/carers should be on hand to support.
- Children should use the 'hands up' icon if they would like to respond to a question.
- Parents to support children using the 'chat' function to give their answers.
