Summer Term	West Midland Safari Park	As part of our Geography unit, we will be looking at Africa and comparing it to the UK. We will be visiting the safari park to look at their African village and undertake some activities to learn about Africa.	£24.00 per child. (This price includes park entry and travel costs)
	The Weavers house.	In History, we will be looking at how materials and vehicles were made in Coventry and the impact it has on our life today. The children will be looking at the lifestyle of a weaver in the past, how the weaver used a loom making and join in with weaving cloth.	£5.00 per child (This price includes entry and travel costs)
