Spring Term	Justice Museum (Nottingham)	As part of the 'Crime and Punishment' history topic, the children will meet amazing, costumed characters from Nottingham's history in Shire Hall. They will explore the Victorian Courtroom, Georgian gaol, and ancient cells - all spread over five fascinating floors. The exhibition are themes of social justice and how the law changed in British history.	£21.80 total cost of visit and transport.
Summer Term	Doly Moch Residential (Wales)	The centre provides a variety of outdoor experiences such as mountain walking, climbing, abseiling, canoeing, kayaking, orienteering and beach studies. The centre is a large 17 th century country house set in gardens and woodland in the Vale of Ffestiniog, Wales.	£176 total cost £88 for children in receipt of pupil premium
Summer Term	Elite Sports (for children not attending residential) (School grounds)	The activities that the children will be completing throughout the day include team building, archery, building a shelter and climbing. For the climbing activity, the children will be scaling up and down a 30-foot wall.	£13 total cost for equipment and trained experts in adventurous activities.
Summer Term	Drayton Manor (Tamworth)	A reward trip at the end of the year to celebrate all of the achievement of finishing SATs and end of primary education.	£13 total cost for discounted tickets and transport
