Starting next week, children will attend their full Nursery sessions. Please refer to the session times listed below for details.

Next week, you will receive your child's Seesaw login details. This will grant you access to their online Learning Journal, a fantastic tool to keep track of what your child has been exploring and learning in Nursery.

You'll also be able to communicate with me directly through Seesaw, and I will share important updates and Nursery information. Expect to see at least one weekly entry for your child, provided they've attended Nursery that week.

This week, we have been focusing on helping the children learn the routines of Nursery. The children are getting used to stopping when they hear the tambourine, learning proper handwashing techniques, and practising tidying up after playtime—although tidying still needs some practise!

The wonderful weather has allowed us to spend more time outside, and we've even enjoyed snack time as a picnic on the field. We've also been coming together for Rhyme Time, which the children are thoroughly enjoying.
